

# A trial collection of plastics products will begin

Turning plastics products from garbage to resources

How to put out plastics products?

Put all plastics into one bag and put it out at a designated collection site.



What is categorized as plastics?

\*PET bottles are collected in the same way as before.

Items that are made of plastic only and not dirty

(measuring less than 30 cm per side)

(Items with a "Plastic containers and packaging"

sign are included.)

## **Examples**

#### Turning plastics from garbage to resources





CDs. DVDs, cases, etc.



Plastic straws, forks,



### Plastic containers.

#### Plastic tovs





Electric toys and battery-powered toys are not included.



★ Put in a clear bag.

#### Items that cannot be collected as plastics

Items with smell or stains even after lightly rinsed

Items mostly made of non-plastic materials such as metal

Plastic items having a blade or razor Disposable lighters that can cause a fire

Plastic items with unremovable battery (rechargeable battery, mobile battery, etc.)

Plastic items measuring more than 30 cm per side

Injectin needles and plastic products used in home care

Burnable trash

Ceramic, glass, and metal trash

Put in a clear bag (write きけん on it) Ceramic, glass, and metal trash.

Put in a small home appliances collection box, or collection box at retail stores.

Bulky trash

Needles returned to the medical institution, Dispose of syringes and drip tubes as combustible waste after removing needles.

Plastics will be collected in an expanded area within Shinagawa City from 2023, with the aim of expandingto all areas in the city from 2024.
