

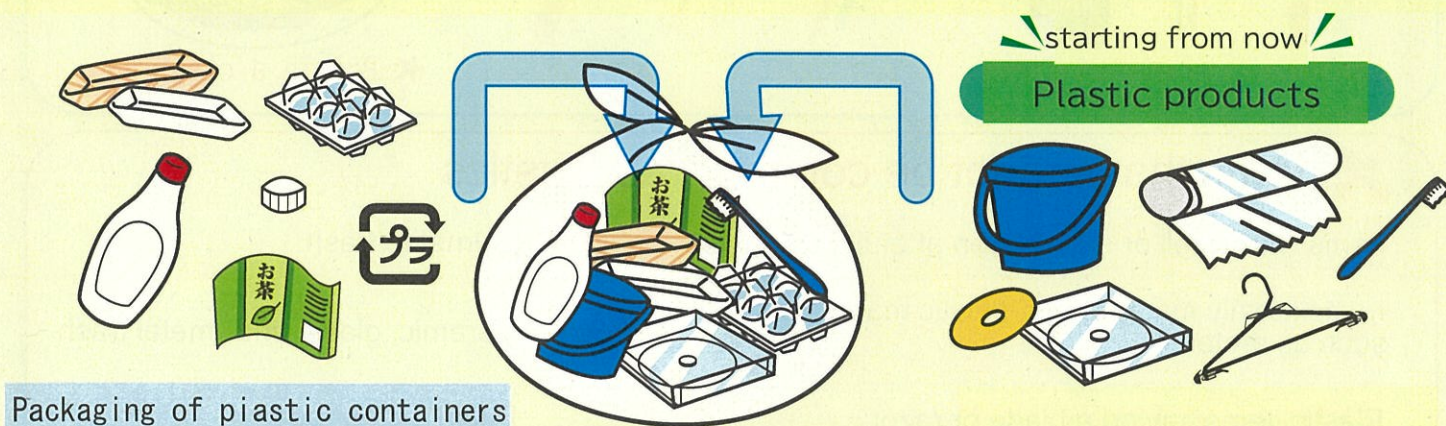

A trial collection of plastics products will begin

Turning plastics products from garbage to resources

How to put out plastics products?

Put all plastics into one bag and put it out at a designated collection site.




What is categorized as plastics?

※PET bottles are collected in the same way as before.



Items that are made of plastic only and not dirty
(measuring less than 30 cm per side)

(Items with a "Plastic containers and packaging"

sign  are included.)

Examples

Turning plastics from garbage to resources

Plastic ballpoint pens,
paper folders, etc.



※ Finish up ink or
take a refill out

CDs, DVDs, cases, etc.



Plastic straws, forks,
spoons, etc.



Plastic containers,
dress hangers, colanders, etc.



Plastic combs, toothbrushes,
etc.



Plastic toys



★Electric toys and
battery-powered toys
are not included.



★ Put in a clear bag.

✗ Items that cannot be collected as plastics

Items with smell or stains even after lightly rinsed

→ Burnable trash

Items mostly made of non-plastic materials
such as metal

→ Ceramic, glass, and metal trash

Plastic items having a blade or razor
Disposable lighters that can cause a fire

→ Put in a clear bag
(write きけん on it)
Ceramic, glass, and metal trash.

Plastic items with unremovable battery
(rechargeable battery, mobile battery, etc.)

→ Put in a small home appliances
collection box, or collection box
at retail stores.

Plastic items measuring more than 30 cm per side

→ Bulky trash

Injectin needles and piastic products used in home care

→ Needles returned to the medical institution,
Dispose of syringes and drip tubes as
combustible waste after removing needles.

Plastics will be collected in an expanded area within Shinagawa City from 2023, with the aim of expanding to all areas in the city from 2024.
