

# Recyclable Plastics

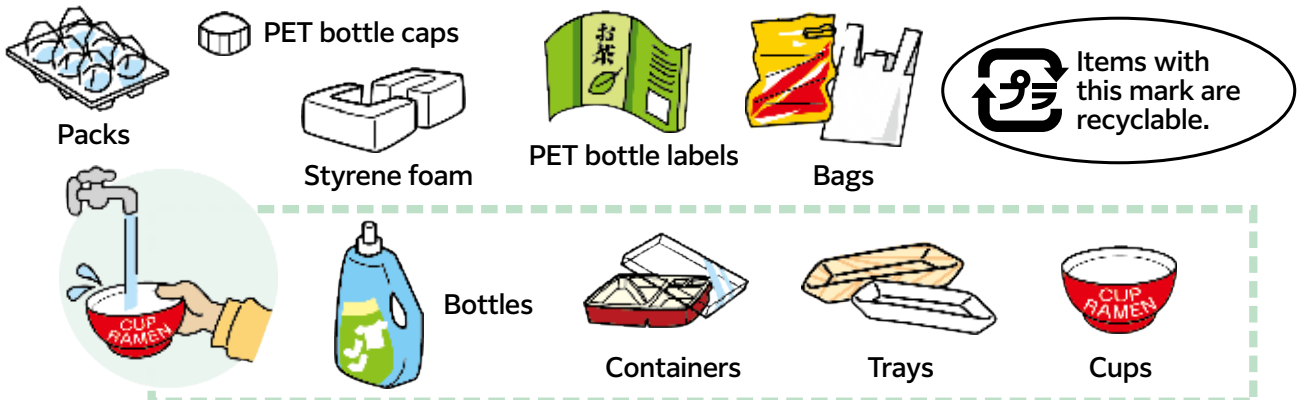
(Packaging of plastic containers and plastic products)

Once a week/Collected on the day for recyclable resource collection from the same recyclable resource collection site as before

**Collection will be implemented in all areas of Shinagawa City starting April 2024.**

## ★Packaging of plastic containers that were already subject to collection

●Please clean dirty items before disposal.

## ★Plastic products that will be newly subject to collection

(Products that are made mostly of plastic and are 30 cm or less on its longest side.)

●Please clean dirty items before disposal.

Plastic stationary such as ball-point pens and clear folders



Note: Use up or remove the ink.

CDs, DVD, etc. (including cases)



Plastic storage containers, hangers, strainers, tableware, lunch boxes, etc.



Plastic toys



★ Electric and battery-powered products are not collected.

**How to dispose**

Please put all items in a single bag (transparent/semi-transparent).

Plastic straws, forks, spoons, etc.



Plastic combs, toothbrushes, etc.



**★Dispose of PET bottles in separate bags as before.**

## Items not collected as plastic resources

### ✕ Not collected

- **Dirty items** (uncleanable)
- **Items made mostly of wood, metal, or other non-plastic materials**
- **Plastic products with blades**  
Items such as disposable lighters **with risk of igniting**
- **Electric and battery-powered (with rechargeable, mobile batteries, etc.) plastic products**
- **Plastic products larger than 30 cm**
- **Syringes and other plastic products used for home medical care**

Dispose of as **combustible waste**

Dispose of as **combustible waste** or **ceramics/glass/metal garbage**

Place in a transparent/semi-transparent bag, label it “**危険 (Dangerous)**”, and dispose of as **ceramics/glass/metal waste**

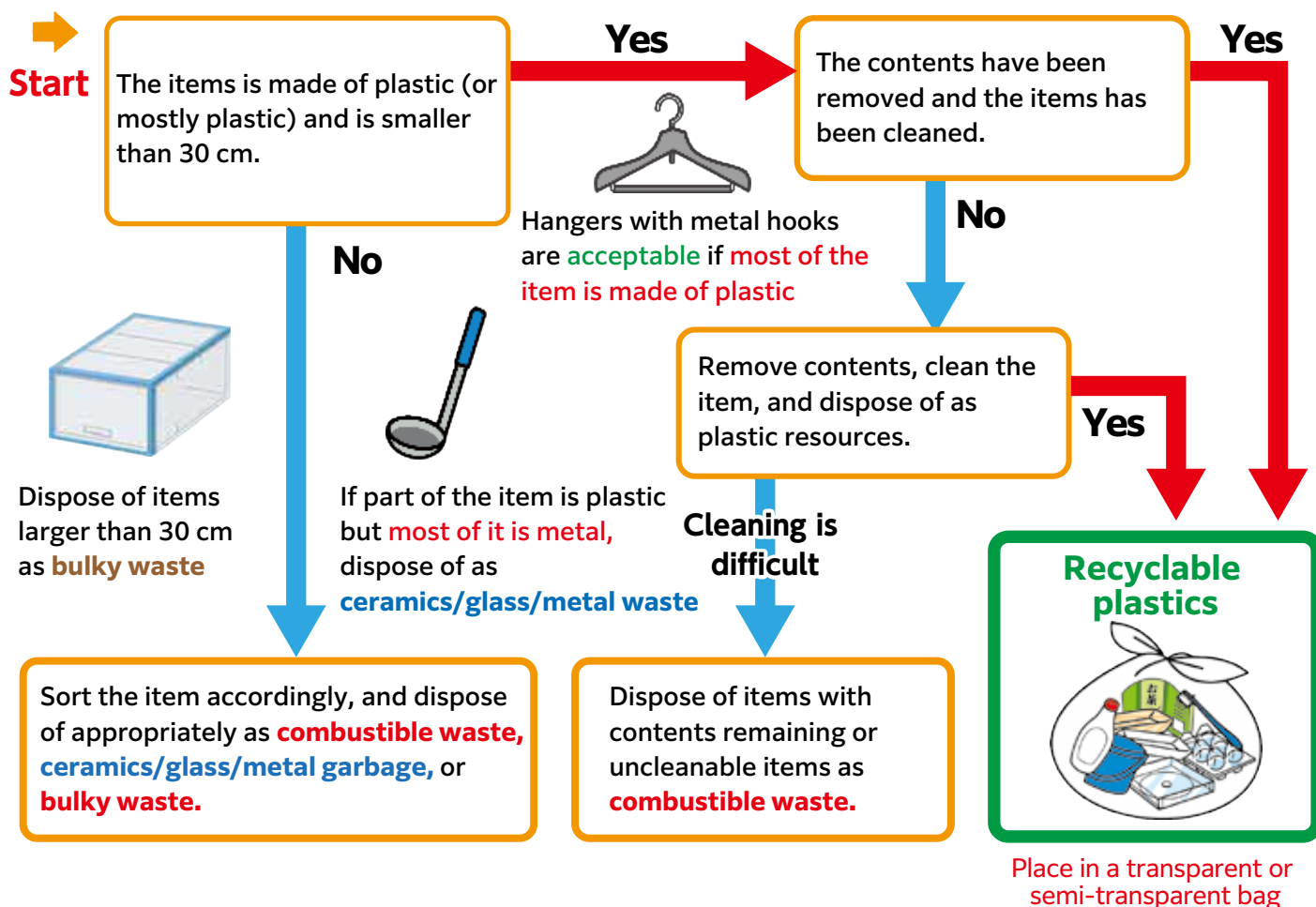
Dispose of at **electronic devices boxes** (dispose of rechargeable batteries at collection boxes at retailers, etc.)

Dispose of as **bulky waste**

Bring needles to medical institutions or cooperating pharmacies  
Dispose of containers, tubes and the like as **combustible waste**

## Guide to sorting recyclable plastics

★If non-plastic parts can be easily removed, remove them before disposal and only dispose of the plastic parts.
